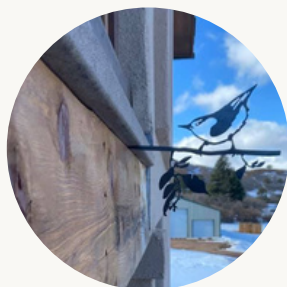

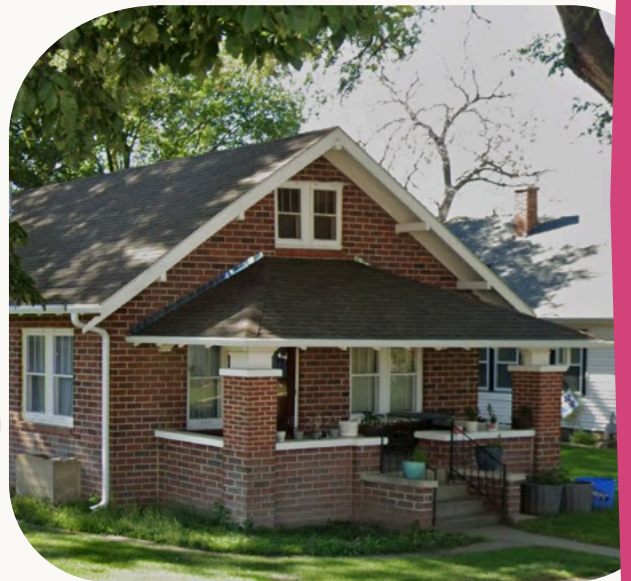

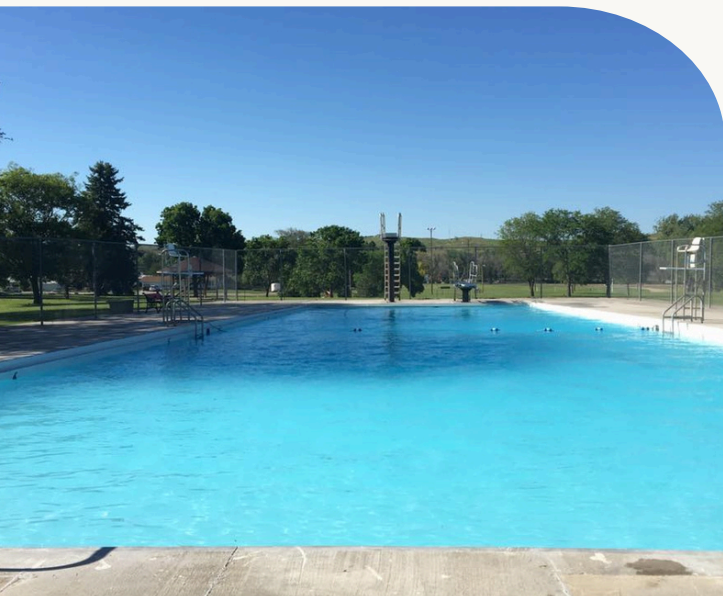
ENDERS LAKE GOLF

A seasonal community pool offering a refreshing way to cool off during the summer months, perfect for families and swimmers of all ages.



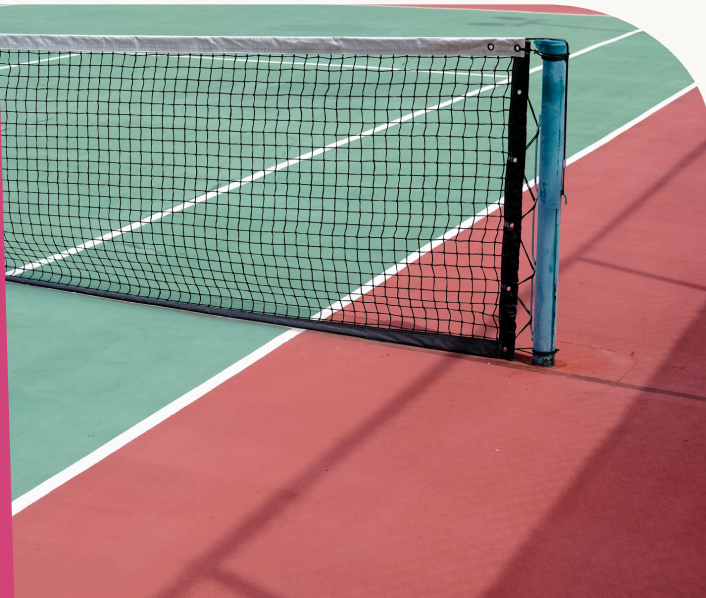

HUNTING & FISHING

Southwest Nebraska offers exceptional hunting and fishing opportunities across diverse landscapes. Hunters can pursue pheasants, ducks, geese, quail, wild turkeys, mule deer, and whitetail deer throughout the region's grasslands and river corridors. Anglers enjoy access to waters stocked with largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, northern pike, walleye, and crappie, making the area a destination for both casual and experienced outdoorsmen.

ENDERS LAKE & RESERVOIR

Enders Reservoir State Recreation Area is one of four areas collectively known as the Southwest Reservoirs. Encompassing 5,700 acres, this area blends recreational opportunities with protected wildlife lands. During fall and winter, portions of the area are designated as a wildlife refuge, preserving natural habitats and limiting development. With wide-open spaces and uncrowded surroundings, Enders Lake is an ideal escape for outdoor enthusiasts seeking peace, nature, and scenic beauty.



HISTORY & LANDMARKS

Step back in time and explore Wauneta's rich history. From the iconic Wauneta Roller Mills to historic downtown buildings and local museums, our town's story is woven through the landmarks that still stand today. Take a stroll, learn something new, and see how Wauneta's past continues to shape its bright future.





WAUNETA ROLLER MILL

Built in 1925 by Bert Maxfield, the Wauneta Roller Mills launched three generations of Maxfield family flour millers and became a cornerstone of the local economy. Known for its Wauneta's Best Flour, the mill has maintained a tradition of care, craftsmanship, and attention to detail for nearly a century. The roller mill offers a living connection to Wauneta's agricultural heritage and a true piece of Southwest Nebraska history.

CHATEAU THEATRE

A beloved historic landmark in downtown Wauneta, the Chateau Theatre has long served as a place for entertainment, connection, and shared experiences. From classic films to community events, the theatre reflects Wauneta's enduring appreciation for arts, storytelling, and coming together.





BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA SCOUT HOUSE

A historic building that has served generations of youth and stands as a testament to leadership, service, and community involvement.



GEORGE ROWLEY HISTORICAL SITE

Near this site once stood the Rowley sod house, built in 1875 as the first habitation in Chase County. George Rowley was killed on October 3, 1878, while traveling home to protect his family during the historic trek of Dull Knife's Band.



LITTLE GRAND CANYON

Also known as the Lovitt Site, this nationally recognized historic location features rugged terrain and sweeping views that have earned it the nickname “Little Grand Canyon.” Once a spring-fed creek flowing between high bluffs, the site also served as a key watering stop along the historic Texas cattle trail used to drive herds north to Ogallala.

DEVIL’S DEN

Located south of Wauneta, this striking canyon is known for its steep limestone and sandstone walls and scientific importance in studying ancient soil and climate conditions. Much of the surrounding land is privately owned, and visitors should seek permission before accessing the area.
